## **Projects Requiring a Building Permit**

Building Permits in the Village of Granton are required for projects exceeding a value of \$1000. *Note*: This is the Value of the project not what you paid. The projects most likely to require a permit are new structures or projects that require you to remove and replace items otherwise considered permanent. If you are replacing a furnace you need a building permit, if you are replacing your washer and dryer, no permit is needed. If you side or replacing siding on your house, you need a permit, if you are painting your house, you do not. Other projects that require permits include:

- 2 build a garage or shed.
- ! installing a new driveway
- It changing the use of a room (converting a garage to a living room)
- ! re-roof your house
- ! install new windows
- 2 add or replace a deck
- ② erect a fence or retaining wall
- 2 adding or replacing kitchen cabinets

Not all construction requires a building permit. Projects that don't usually need a permit include:

- 2 painting your house
- Preplacing most appliances
- seal coating your driveway
- ! replacing carpet
- erecting a small decorative fence or trellis
- ! installing a garden

## Costs:

- Building permits are ten dollars plus a dollar for every \$1000 in value.
- 2 example: A building permit for a \$10,000 roof would be \$20.00

## To Apply for a building permit:

- ② download from web site and fill out the building permit application Villageofgranton.com (government tab)
  - Is send application with fees to: Village of Granton, Box 69, Granton WI
  - Permits are approved at the board meeting and sent out after approval
  - post your building permit in your window
  - 2 permits are valid for 1 year
